ELIGIBILITY

The Goshen College Art Club & Art Department is pleased to announce special thematic Student Art Exhibit, November 28 – March 16. This year's theme is North & South and all submitted pieces must represent this theme in some form. The show is open to all current Goshen College students. Each entrant may submit one (1) or two (2) works which must be original in concept and execution and created this year. All media are acceptable except for digital productions that require monitors. Length or width may not exceed five (5) feet. All 2-D pieces must be matted and ready to hang and all 3-D pieces must be free standing or have a base.

ARTIST STATEMENTS

No artwork will be accepted without a properly filled out entry forms and artist statement (see other side). Some artist statements or excerpts will be displayed in the exhibit, but not all will be used.

ENTRIES DUE

All works must be delivered before Friday, November 18 at 4pm to the Library Gallery (basement in the Good Library). Artwork will be juried for connection to the theme and space limitations.

ACCEPTED WORK

Accepted works must remain for the duration of the exhibition and may be picked up from the Library Gallery between March 19 & 21 during regular library hours.

NON-ACCEPTED WORK

Non-accepted work must be picked-up between November 28 & December 2 during regular library hours.

RESPONSIBILITIES & SALES

The Goshen College Art Club & Art Department are not responsible for any damage to pieces during the exhibit. There will be no prices listed as part of this exhibit, but potential buyers will be encouraged to contact individual artists if they are interested in purchasing a piece.
